

PRIVACY POLICY OF EUCW.ORG

Short version: Technically eucw.org is a sub page of agcw.de of the German Telegraphy Activity Group AGCW-DL. AGCW-DL hosts eucw.org as a donation to EUCW. As such the privacy policy of AGCW-DL applies. Read it on AGCW.de. Even the domain eucw.org is a donation from AGCW-DL.

Links:

EUCW is a host org for telegraphy club. As such we have a link collection of most participating clubs. Each third party web site is subject to its own privacy policy.

Responsibility:

EUCW is lead by its chairman. The chairman's term of office is three years. Consult the officers link to identify the present chairman and the present webmaster. The list of responsible persons of the hosting AGCW-DL is available on agcw.de. Furthermore, a general address is given on the "Write us" link.

Logs:

EUCW has no access to log files. Hence EUCW does neither use nor process any log data.

Scripts/Cookies:

eucw.org is not using scripts and it is not using cookies.

Personal information:

Individuals may be named for functional purposes such as addresses of award managers or contest managers. The main players in EUCW are the EUCW communication managers (ECM) that are appointed by the member clubs to form the network structure of EUCW. By default, the ECM are named by their first name and Amateur Radio Call Sign. eucw.org tries to obfuscate email addresses with various methods in order to reduce the spam load that out volunteers are exposed to. Our preferred obfuscation method is

to give out email addresses as audio files coded in Morse telegraphy since our award applicants and contest participants are all familiar with Morse code while the general public may hardly decode audio Morse.

Language:

By EUCW statute we are using English for communication. All ECM should have a reasonable command of English to be functional. Some pages are directed to radio amateurs in national languages, typically rules for activities and operational hints. eucw.org trusts their volunteer translators that they abide by our rules and that the translations are correct. The translators are responsible for their texts and they are identified by their Amateur Radio call sign.

Copyright:

the nature of our organization is to make all information available to our member clubs. Unless indicated otherwise or dictated by common sense all material from this site may be used freely.

Consent:

the use of the page is understood as acceptance of our privacy policy *and* the privacy policy of our host and donor AGCW-DL.

Corrections/updates:

if any individual named in our pages and on other material asks for modifications or updates, the volunteers working on this page will do their best to honor such a request. See contact.

Transparency:

You are entitled to be informed about any data we have recorded about you in the domain eucw.org. In case you have volunteered for EUCW in any form, we may have data about you in our files, if you have never worked as a volunteer for EUCW it is almost certain that we have no records about you. In most cases we will have hardly more than your call sign and first name.
